Committed To The Highest Level Of Care

Southeastern Home Health Services is licensed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, certified to participate in the Medicare and Medicaid programs and accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations.

- Nurses (for intermittent visits and private duty up to 24 hours a day)
- Physical, Occupational and Speech Therapists
- Medical Social Workers
- Home Health Aides and Homemakers



All staff members meet the requirements for education, training, experience, criminal background checks, drug testing and health screening. All are bonded, licensed and insured.

Individualized Care Plan

Southeastern Home Health Services provides intermittent nursing and therapy visits that are ordered by a physician and covered by private insurance, Medicare, Medicaid or HMOs. We take care of requesting orders from the physician as well as any authorization that may be necessary from an insurance company. We handle all third party billing.

When a patient needs or requests private duty nursing we can provide either RN or LPN coverage. This service might be as short as a two hour shift up to round-the-clock care.

Southeastern Home Health Services also provides home health aides and homemakers to assist our patients with personal care and household tasks. All home health aides and homemakers are supervised by a nurse and render care that is part of a care plan created and overseen by a nurse manager. While an aide may initially be part of the care team when a patient is receiving skilled services from a nurse or therapist, many of our patients choose to continue this service after they no longer require skilled services.

Although home health aide and homemaker services may not be covered by insurance, we will investigate a patient's financial coverage possibilities. Some patients may be covered by long term care insurance or are able to receive payment for home health aide and homemaker services through organizations such as Area Agencies on Aging and the Veterans Administration.

Flexibility of Care

Because Southeastern Home Health Services is a provider of both skilled and non-skilled services, it's easy, convenient and often comfortable for a patient to remain with us even when their home health care needs

or desires change. There is no need to switch agencies when skilled services become needed or when help with homemaking skills is desired. We can bring all services to a patient's home and handle all third party billing.
